One individual can save up to eight lives by donating organs upon dying. They can also improve the quality of life of 15 other people through tissue donation.




Sign the organ and tissue donation sticker and put it on the back of your health insurance card in the space provided.

Talk about it!

Make sure that your wishes are honored.

It is very important to discuss and share your decision with your family and loved ones. Upon your death, your next of kin will be asked if you consented to donating an organ or tissue. This person and the others with whom you have discussed your decision will be able to speak on your behalf and ensure that your wishes are honored.

Make your consent official by having it recorded in the *Registre* des consentements au don d'organes et de tissus.
