

QUEBEC'S PUBLIC CLINICAL TRIALS REGISTRY

Quebec has an automated bilingual (French and English) database that is accessible online to facilitate the recruitment of participants for clinical trials (the [Registry](#)).

The Registry offers health professionals, researchers, and other stakeholders (including the public) access to information on the clinical trials. The goal is for the Registry to contain information on all clinical trials conducted in Quebec.

The Registry will be populated by content that is accessible by the public online (ex., from the [clinicaltrials.gov](#) website), as well as through information shared with public health and social services institutions (the **Institutions**) and/or their researchers, and with information they provide themselves, through the Nagano platform. This information may include information contained in the consent forms (French and English) approved by the ethics committee. **The Registry will not include any confidential or personal information.**

The information made available in the Registry will be in French as much as possible, in accordance with the Charter of the French language (CQLR, c. C-11), and in English to ensure that the greatest number of people can consult and understand it.

The sponsor may ask that a project be removed at any time at the following e-mail address: registreQc@semiweb.ca. The supplier of the Registry (4466781 CANADA INC., operating under the name [SEMI Solutions Médicales](#)) has agreed to remove the project within 2 working days after a request for removal is submitted.
